We invite students to present their work at the <u>2025 NBGI-PIF joint meeting</u> to be held in Clemson, South Carolina, 28-31 July 2025. By submitting an abstract, the presenter agrees to register and deliver the poster presentation if it is accepted. We invite submission of abstracts for consideration as poster presentations, which may include completed projects, or be smaller, more concise, or those in early stages of development. We are broadly interested in work associated with Northern Bobwhite, grassland birds and/or ecosystems, eastern birds and/or ecosystems, or other associated species (e.g., gopher tortoises, pollinators, etc.).

Abstracts are limited to 1750 characters including spaces (approximately 250 words), and should include 1-2 sentences of background information, 1-2 sentences stating the question or hypothesis, a brief summary of methods, and a summary of key results and interpretation. Please be concise, use first person, and avoid ambiguous statements (e.g., "results will be discussed"). You will also be asked to provide a title, authors and affiliations, and an email address for the corresponding presenter on the submission form.
